BRANCH PICK UP BEGINS... MAY 4th

Bundled branches will be picked up SIX TIMES in 2026 beginning the FIRST MONDAY of MAY and continuing through October. The start dates and the rules are listed to the right. You may want to save this list so you can time your trimming to our pick-up dates.

Have your **tyed up bundles** at curbside or roadside by 6:30 a.m. on those Monday mornings. Our crew is on a rotating street schedule and it may take

them 3 to 5 days to complete the branch collection. They will visit each area and street *only once*.

Branches must be tied up in bundles. We will leave a “red tag” explanation if we don’t pick up your branches.

- START DATES**
- MAY 4 (MONDAY)
 - JUNE 1 (MONDAY)
 - JULY 6 (MONDAY)
 - AUGUST 3 (MONDAY)
 - SEPTEMBER 8 (TUESDAY)
 - OCTOBER 5 (MONDAY)

FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- ◇ **Branches cut to 4 feet**
- ◇ **Branch diameter 4 inches or less**
- ◇ **Bundles must be tied with twine or string (no wire or plastic)**
- ◇ **Bundles up to 25 lbs. only**



Our program is intended to help homeowners with the disposal of tree and shrub branches that do not qualify as yard waste. If it fits in a yard waste bag it should not be in the roadside bundle. Our collection service is not meant to remove whole trees.

Please make other arrangements for removal when a tree is cut down.

Please don’t put your branch bundles in the street. Place them in the parkway closest to the curb or the edge of the road. Also, we may not be able to pick them up if a parked

car is in the way.

This Road District service is offered only to residences along the roads that we maintain in unincorporated Lisle Township. Please call if you are unsure if we service your road.

SIDEWALK SQUARE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Deadline Monday, July 6th

To help homeowners replace cracked, raised or sunken sidewalks, Lisle Township Road District will pick up more than half the cost when we replace. Call 630-964-0057 or email: highway@lisle-township.com by July 6th to be put on the sidewalk replacement list.

Your special cost will be \$1.25 per square foot which is \$31.25 for the typical 5' x 5' section. Mark the squares you wish to replace with a dot of white paint. Our superintendent

will leave an invoice-agreement form after he measures.

Return the form with payment in full. The work usually begins in August.

Project start dates have not yet been determined.

FLYERS will be distributed to the homes along these streets about 5 days before construction begins. They will explain the repair process and outline any driving and parking restrictions.

RECLAMITE

We apply surface treatments to preserve and restore other **township roads.**

Reclamite is a sealant used on one year old roads and is reapplied every 4 years. The following roads are scheduled:

Our reclamite contractor will seal one side of the street at a time, so at least one lane is open for resident traffic. The sealants need up to four hours of drying time before the lane is opened.

CRACK-FILL

Crack-filling seals cracks too big for the other products to repair. Contractors clean out the cracks then fill them.

Residents living on streets where this work will be done will be notified by flyer before the work starts.

Our goal is to provide safe, durable and attractive roads and right-of-ways, while minimizing inconvenience to residents.

CONCRETE

Each season, some curbing is scheduled for replacement. **If** curbing is to be replaced through your driveway, a **pink dot** will be spray painted there to indicate so. You will be given ample notice, via flyer, to move your car out of the driveway. The driveway will not be accessible for approximately 5-7 days. We apologize for any inconvenience.



CALL... JULIE BEFORE YOU DIG.COM
Protect Yourself And Your Family

J.U.L.I.E., INC. is a not-for-profit corporation dedicated to keeping Illinois safe and connected. JULIE stands for **J**oint **U**tility **L**ocating **I**nformation for **E**xcavators.

In Illinois, safe digging starts when you call JULIE at **8-1-1** (the nationwide 3 digit number to have your underground utility lines marked at no cost) or go online to enter a locate request at <https://www.illinois1call.com/remoteticketentry>.

State law requires you to notify JULIE at least two but not more than 14 business days before any digging project regardless of the project size or depth. Even if you are digging in the same area as previous projects, notify JULIE first!

Across the country, every few minutes an underground utility line is damaged because someone decided to dig without contacting a one-call center such as JULIE first. Again, this is a **free service**. *JULIE neither owns nor marks any underground utility lines.*

APPROVED TREES TO PLANT IN LISLE TOWNSHIP PARKWAYS

NOTE: 1. Tree branching must not interfere with overhead utilities, structures, or truck traffic. 2. One parkway tree permitted per standard lot; two permitted for corner lots. 3. Minimum trunk diameter is 2-1/2 inches unless otherwise approved. 4. Locate all underground utilities.

Hickory	Spring Only	No
Kentucky Coffee Tree	Spring and Fall	Yes

Honeylocust	Spring and Fall	Yes
Black Gum	Spring Only	Varies
Maple (Except silver & boxelder)	Spring and Fall	Yes
Turkish Filbert	Spring and Fall	Varies
Linden (Basswood)	Spring Only	Varies
Gingko, male only	Spring and Fall	Yes
London Plane Tree	Spring and Fall	Varies
Bald Cypress	Spring and Fall	Varies
Elm, Disease Resistant	Spring and Fall	Yes
